

George Brett, Joe D., and the 56-Game Streak

Using Retrosheet to Find the Top 56-Game Batting Averages Since 1897

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Recently I have been having conversations with fellow baseball fans about the 1980 season. It had three terrific divisional races: one between the Yankees and the Orioles in the AL East, another between the Phillies and Expos in the NL East, and the third between the Astros and the Dodgers in the NL West. In the latter two, just 1 game separated the winner from second place. In the AL East, 3 games separated the teams. The AL West was a runaway, with the Royals finishing 14 games ahead of the rival Athletics. The playoffs were dramatic, especially in the NL, where the Phillies and Astros battled into extra innings in Games 2 through 5, with Philly coming out on top, 3 games to 2. KC upended the Yankees in three straight games, with George Brett winning Game 3 with a decisive 3-run homer against Goose Gossage in the 8th. The Phillies won the World Series, 4 games to 2. Steve Stone went 25-7 for the Orioles to win the AL Cy Young while Steve Carlton won his 3rd of 4 NL Cy Young Awards, with a 24-9 mark. Rookies of the Year? Dodgers' reliever Steve Howe in the NL and – you guessed it – the Indians' Joe Charboneau for the Junior Circuit. (I'm not sure if the AL resented the "Junior Circuit" nickname or not.) The MVPs were two future Hall of Fame thirdbasemen: in the NL, Mike Schmidt led the league in HRs (48), RBIs (121), and Slugging (.624). Over in the American League, George Brett grabbed the most 1st place votes despite playing in only 117 games. Brett, as you probably remember, batted .390, beating Rod Carew's most recent high-water mark in 1977 of .388 mark by 2 points. Squeaking over the minimum number of Plate Appearances (502) by just 13 (515), Brett led the league in Batting Average (.390), On-Base Percentage (.454), and Slugging Percentage (.664). He also drove in 118 runs in just 117 games.

However, the season did not start out like gangbusters for Brett. He had his ups and downs early, and at the end of the day on May 21st, having gone 0-for-6, he was at .247 (but with a respectable .802 OPS). After that, though, he started to find his groove. An 8-for-20 streak preceded a hitless game, and he followed with a 6-for-13 to bring his average up to .287, with an .874 OPS. Then he really took off – but it was sort of a delayed takeoff. On May 31st, he went 3-for-4 to push him over .300 for the year for good. Less than two weeks later, then at .337, he was sidelined with an injury that kept him out of the lineup until July 10th. Once he returned, he just kept on hitting. On August 26th, he was at .407 after a 5-for-5 game – his highest mark of the season. I recall a picture in my local newspaper of Brett standing on second base with his hands in the air, doffing his batting helmet up to the wildly appreciative Kansas City crowd after passing the .400 mark. I think I found an image of it. It may have been the game on August 17th when he went 4-for-4 to finish the day at .401:



In that span, from May 31st to August 26th, Brett went from .287 to .407, an incredible 120-point increase. In Baseball Reference if you select that span of games and summarize, you'll get this line:

A staggering .476 batting average. For about 2 months' worth of games, Brett got a hit just about every other time he put the ball in play.

I noticed that this surge took place over a span of 56 games. With the number "56" attached to one of the most recognizable feats in baseball history, I decided to look at the span of Joe DiMaggio's 1941 record 56-game hitting streak for comparison. Here's what Baseball Reference showed me for DiMaggio between May 15th and July 16th:

Pretty good, right? Brett, while his longest hitting streak was 30 games, did manage to get a hit in 52 of those games, besting DiMaggio by about 60+ points across AVG, OBP, and SLG.

For better or worse, down the Retrosheet rabbit hole I went. I wanted to know whether any other players had stretches of 56 games that came close to Brett's and DiMaggio's. I used the Retrosheet Batting Game Logs to try and find out. First, I focused on Brett's 1980 season to try and make sure I was figuring everything correctly. I also wanted to know if he had any other great stretch of the same length in his career? Given he won 3 batting titles and finished with a .305 career average, I figured he might have. So, I went digging.

First, some ground rules:

- 1) I wanted to find his best stretch of games within a season, with no crossing over from one season to another
- 2) The number of games is somewhat arbitrary – 56 – but I liked the synergy with DiMaggio's streak
- 3) The stretch of games had to contain a significant number of plate appearances. I settled on a minimum of 174, which is 56 times 3.1, 173.6, rounded up to 174
- 4) I was looking for stretches of games where the Batting Average was .400 or above

During a season, a player has many “sets” of 56 games. For example, Brett played 117 games in 1980, so he had 62 distinct sets of 56 consecutive games: games 1-56, 2-57, 3-58, all the way up to games 62-117, each representing a set of 56 games. I was looking for the best set – defined by the highest Batting Average – among those 62. Two things came out of the initial research:

- 1) In 1980, the May 31st-August 26th stretch was his best for that season
- 2) In 1985 he had another 56-game set when his average was over .400. Between May 21st and July 30th, he hit .404:

Joe DiMaggio – 1941

How about Joe DiMaggio's 1941 season? It turns out that the 56-game hitting streak was not the best 56-game set of that season, in terms of Batting Average. It was the set of games between June 1st (Game 2 of the Doubleheader) and August 2nd that squeezed past the streak itself (.419 vs. .408):

His 17-game hitting streak after the 56-game streak ended offered an additional push on the back end to hit the .419 mark.

In his career, DiMaggio had two other 56-game sets with a .400+ BA:

- 1) 1937: June 22nd through August 19th

So, DiMaggio edges Brett on that count, 3 sets to 2.

Ted Williams - 1941

Speaking of 1941, I looked for Ted Williams' best 56-game set of the season when he hit .406 overall. From July 16th to September 10th, the Splendid Splinter checked in at .436, *raising* his average from .397 to .413:

Recent Seasons of Note

How about two other recent (well, still in my memory) runs at .400?

Tony Gwynn - 1994

In 1994, Tony Gwynn wound up at .394, the closest run at .400 in quite a long time. What was Gwynn's best set of 56 games during that season?

From June 11th to August 11th, Gwynn hit .408, before the strike stopped play, wiping out the last 45 games of the Padres' season.

Gwynn has 3 other 56-game sets with an average of .400 or better, including one in 1997 (.425) when he won the last of his 8 batting titles:

- 1) 1993: .410 -- June 30th to September 4th
- 2) 1995: .403 -- June 4th to August 12th
- 3) 1997: .425 -- May 13th to July 17th

Rod Carew – 1977

In 1977, Rod Carew flirted with .400 before settling in at a tidy .388, up to that point the highest Batting Average for anyone since Ted Williams in 1957.

On the morning of April 27th Carew's average was a mere .329. Between April 27th and July 2nd, he hit an amazing .434 to raise his average to .408! In fact, on July 2nd, he went 0-for-2 which *dropped* his average from .411 to .408.

Carew, winner of 7 batting titles, has 2 other 56-game sets with an average of .400 or better:

- 1) 1974: .404 -- April 13th to June 20th
- 2) 1983: .412 -- April 16th to July 12th

Is Brett's .476 the Highest Ever for an In-Season 56-Game Set?

Expansion Era: 1961 through 2025

Of the initial “player seasons” I looked at, Brett's .476 Batting Average was the highest by a wide margin: 42 points ahead of Carew's 1977 stretch. But is it the highest Batting Average of all-time (or at least for those seasons where we have the batting game logs) over a 56-game stretch in a single season? In the expansion era, 1961-2025, Brett's .476 **is** the highest mark, beating Ichiro's mark of .466 in 2004 by 10 points. Here's the top 20 averages:

Notes:

- 1) **Start** and **End** are the Month-Day values the 56-game set started and ended, respectively. For example, 0531 is May 31st.
- 2) **GWH** is the # of Games that the player had a Hit in during the 56-game span. For example, George Brett had a hit in 52 of the 56 Games represented in his 1980 set.

A handful of names that you would expect (Brett, Ichiro, Carew, Boggs, Gwynn), some you would not have expected (Johnny Damon, maybe Chipper and Tony Fernandez), and others we may have forgotten about, like Magglio Ordonez, who won the AL Batting Title in 2007 (.363), and Nomar Garciaparra, who led the AL in 2000 at .372. Most of the entries on this list were from the more recent “Lively Ball” era, which lasted from about 1993 through 2009 or so. Only four are from before 1988: Brett's 1980, Carew's 1977, and Wade Boggs' 1985 and 1987.

You may have noticed that Jose Altuve snuck in there as the most recent entry on the list. With Batting Averages sinking, you wouldn't expect a lot of post-2009 seasons on the list, and you'd be right. Since Altuve's stretch in 2017, only two players managed to make the list: Aaron Judge in 2025 and Luis Arraez in 2023. Here's the list of the seasons in which a player accomplished the .400 mark since 2009, starting with the most recent. Josh Hamilton's .427 is the highest of this group:

Jose Altuve makes the list twice, in 2016 and 2017.

In all, that's just 9 times in 16 seasons. From 1993 to 2009 (17 seasons), it happened 42 times. In 1994 and 2000, there were five instances each, tied for the most in any season in the expansion era.

Post World War II ERA – 1946 through 2025

How about expanding the range back to 1946, where we'll catch seasons of some of MLB's greatest hitters, like Stan Musial and Ted Williams? Here is the Top 20 from 1946 to 2025:

Four seasons creep into the list: 2 from Ted Williams (1947 and 1948), 1 from Stan Musial (1948), and 1 from Tito Francona (1959). Brett is still #1.

Toppling Brett from the #1 Spot

How far back do you have to go to find someone who beats Brett's 1980 mark of .476? That would be 1924, when Rogers Hornsby batted .424 for the whole season, and had a 56-game stretch from July 5th to August 29th where he put up a .485 Batting Average, besting Brett by 9 points:

When he started the streak, Hornsby was at .395; he was hitting .434 at the end of it.

That was one of 8 seasons in which Hornsby had a 56-game set where he batted .400 and above:

Ty Cobb – The King of the 56 Game Streak

While Rajah's record of 8 is impressive, it lags far behind that of Ty Cobb, the perennial American League batting champion (12 titles), who has the most 56-Game Sets on the list (13), with 3 better than .450:

Note: The Retrosheet Batter Game Logs include seasons 1897-1900, so those are included as well. Wee Willie Keeper is the highest of those earlier seasons, checking at #8 on the list with a .459 average. 1897 is represented 4 times, when the NL batted .292 in aggregate.

Seasons with 4+ Players with a .400 Average over a 56-Game Span

Before running the numbers somewhat more exhaustively, I expected there would be more “.400+ sets” in years where batting averages are higher. (I understand that’s not an Einstein or Sherlock Holmes-level theory, of course, but it was worth testing.) Sure enough, most of the seasons with the highest number of players putting up a .400 stretch over 56 games are from “lively ball” seasons:

Using the Batting Game Logs

At the time I used the Log data, the total number of records was 5,771,788

In the Batting Game Logs, I used only the “regular” *gametype* where the *stattype* was equal to “value”

That left me with 5,636,104 records to work with.

When I was reviewing the data over several iterations of the process, I noticed that there were Batting Game Log records where some of the key information I needed, such as Plate Appearances and At Bats and Hits, were NULL, meaning “unknown”/“indeterminate” as opposed to 0.

Note 1: Focusing on just Batting Average, I needed Hits and At Bats, but I also needed Plate Appearances to check for the minimum criteria: 56 Games with 174 Plate Appearances.

Luckily, there were 0 instances where the At Bats were present but not Plate Appearances. However, there were instances where At Bats were not present at all (NULL/Unknown instead of 0). I decided not to use those records, which reduced the total by 11,766. Including them would have potentially added Hits to the player’s running totals, but not the associated At Bats, thus inflating their average. The total left was 5,624,297.

Note 2: There were 41 records where the Plate Appearances are present but not the At Bats. I reviewed those records but decided not to try and deduce the At Bats; some I probably could have made educated guesses on based on the associated data, but not all of them, so I decided not to attempt to bring them back into the set for analysis. Also, I looked up the specific players and seasons, and their inclusion would not have made a difference in those players reaching the .400 mark for inclusion on the list.

Note 3: There were 23 records where the At Bats were available but not the Hits. In a reverse of the situation where there were Hits but no At Bats, I didn’t want to penalize the player’s average by including the At Bats in the running totals but counting the game as 0 Hits. Again, there were only 23 such records in the set, so I removed them.

That left the total Batting Game Logs to consider as 5,624,274.

Note 4: There are 4,208 records of the 5,624,274 where the Hits are present but either the doubles, triples, or home runs are NULL/Unknown instead of 0. Because I was focused on Batting Average, I did not exclude these records but counted the Hits as singles for the purposes of Slugging%. These records are from the Negro Leagues game logs.

Again, most, if not all, of these “incomplete” records represent Game Logs of Negro League Players. In a compromise, I decided to exclude and include a record based on the criteria described in the “Notes” above. I wanted to do my best to include whatever “complete” Game Logs were available, so I simply skipped over an “incomplete” record (unknown Plate Appearances or At Bats or Hits) in those cases as if it wasn’t there. These “incomplete” records were not part of the set of games considered.

Thus, Lester Lockett’s 1948 mark of .410 for the Baltimore Elite Giants is on the list, as is Josh Gibson’s 1933 mark of .40 for the Pittsburgh Crawfords.

My hope is that, as the record continues to grow for the Negro Leagues, this exercise can be rerun based on the latest information. With a more complete dataset, potentially more of the great Negro League stars will be represented in the list.
