# Digging Yourself Into (and Out of) A Hole

OK, OK...I know my team, the Orioles, finished with one of the worst records in recent memory, to which I will say a couple of things right off the bat: (1) I *really* thought they'd crack 50 wins and avoid total embarrassment. I mean, you go 69-93 and you can slide under the national radar, but at 47-115 you get noticed, and people start talking about bringing the idea of "relegation" to MLB. (Fans of Swansea City, Stoke City, and West Bromwich Albion: you know what I'm talking about.) (2) Sure, they were bad, but ... sorry, I can't think of anything here.

The team certainly struggled from the start, but 5-8 after 13 games wasn't terrible, and there was plenty of time to right the ship and start winning some games, right? Even a 6-game losing streak didn't completely dampen spirits. A win perked up the fanbase, but a 5-game losing streak followed, and at 6-19, it was looking bleak. But, hey, this is the age of the second wild card, and even a series win against the woeful Tigers was something to cling to so early in the year. At the end of April, the O's were 8-20, "only" 12 games under but, heck, there was still plenty of time to right the ship and start winning some games, right? Did I already say that? Did I also write about a 7-game losing streak followed by a hopeful 5 wins in 6 games against some hapless teams? Apologies for the broken record, but in that final win (not of the season, smart-alecks), they roughed up the eventual AL Cy Young Award winner, Blake Snell, en route to a 17-1 win. Even at a miserable 15 games under at 13-28, with 120 games to go and Memorial Day still over two weeks away, the second Wild Card was still an attainable goal, right? I mean, the summer hadn't even started yet. How could the season be over before the fans had even settled into it?

While the true nature of this very bad team set in shortly thereafter, I started thinking whether or not a team could dig itself a large hole – like 15 games under .500 – and still make the playoffs. Just how delusional is it to think that a team can save its season with The Big Turnaround? How long does it take to figure out that your team is just plain awful, and that The Miracle isn't just around the corner? For those eternal optimists – those who *just know* Juliet's going to wake up before Romeo drinks the poison – what's the moment when you should avert your eyes and ears to avoid seeing and hearing the post-season balloon burst?

Using the Retrosheet Game Logs, I set out to answer a simple question:

(1) Since 1903 – the first year of the modern World Series – has a team ever been 15 games under .500 and made the playoffs?

Along the way, a few more related questions popped up:

- (2) Has a team ever been 15 games below .500 and finished at or above .500?
- (3) Conversely, has a team ever been 15 games above .500 and finished under .500?

And, finally:

(4) Has a team ever been over .500 by 15 or more games <u>and</u> under .500 by 15 or more games in the same season?

It turns out that these are pretty rare occurrences.

#### **The Ground Rules**

For Question 1 -- 15+ games under .500 and Post-Season bound -- I considered all seasons and teams from 1903 through 2018, with the following exceptions:

- (1) 1904 there was no World Series
- (2) 1915 the Federal League did not participate in the World Series, so they're not in the group for post-season consideration; the AL and NL are considered, of course
- (3) 1981 this was tricky because the post-season teams were not decided by a team's full-season record. The middle-third of the season was scrubbed due to the strike, and the playoff teams were figured by First Half and Second Half Division winners. It turns out that the Royals made the playoffs due to a 30-23 Second Half record, and they had been -13 (11-24) at one point in the First Half. Overall, they were 50-53, with the 4<sup>th</sup> best record (or 4<sup>th</sup> worst, depending from which direction you're looking), which would not have been enough to make the playoffs, even if a Wild Card path had been taken. This situation came up when I lowered the threshold to 10 games. I decided to not consider 1981 for Question 1, but I did have it in the pool for the other questions. Interestingly, there were no repeat first half/second half winners, and 8 different teams made the post-season.
- (4) 1995 there was no Post-Season

These exceptions will be reflected in the following way for Question 1:

(1) The total number of eligible Post-Season Teams across all the Seasons and Leagues does not include them. This value is used for a couple of % summary/perspective calculations.

For Questions 2, 3, and 4, which do not consider appearance in the Post-Season as part of the criteria, all teams from all seasons and teams, 1901-2018, including the Federal League, were considered.

#### Question 1: 15 games under and Post-Season Bound

A team's Final Record may not have been their Best Record

The "Best" and "Worst" Records are the latest in the season that the team reached that particular number of games over or under .500

The "Turnaround" is based on the difference between the Best and Worst Records

Just two teams since 1903 were at one time 15 or more games under .500 and able to make the Post-Season: the "Miracle" Braves of 1914 and the Houston Astros of 2005. The Braves' 82-31 record after a 12-28 start pushed them 10.5 games ahead of the Giants, who faded in August. Not only did they win the NL pennant, but they swept the defending champion Philadelphia Athletics in the World Series, so it might be considered two miracles in the same year. The Astros held on to edge the Phillies for the Wild Card by 1 game, and then beat the Braves and the Cardinals for the NL pennant before falling to the White Sox in the World Series. Sort of a "Mini-Miracle," I guess.

Since 1903, taking into account the season exceptions noted earlier, I counted 850 teams which were that far under .500 at one point in the season, so that makes just 2 teams of 850 - .2% – who were able to turn their seasons completely around in time in a substantial enough way to make the Post-Season.

Because there were so few teams at that level, I lowered the threshold to 10+ games under .500, and that added ten others (ordered by the number of games below .500):

The '74 Pirates just missed cracking the "15-games under" club. They stormed back after a shaky start to take the lead in the NL East, faltered a bit in mid-September, and had to rally back to tie for the lead by the end of the month. They were deadlocked with the Cardinals on September 30<sup>th</sup>, but the Cards lost 3-2 to Montreal on October 1<sup>st</sup> when Mike Jorgensen hit a 2-run HR off Bob Gibson in the bottom of the 8<sup>th</sup>. Meanwhile, the Pirates staged an 8<sup>th</sup> inning rally to beat the Cubs, 6-5. Another rally on the next day – 2 runs in the 9<sup>th</sup> (the last one on a 2-out strikeout and passed ball) and 1 more in the 10<sup>th</sup> – gave the Pirates the division.

The Pirates were simply continuing the NL East dramatics from the year before, when the '73 Mets 29-13 mark over their last 42 games saw them come out on top of a crazy pennant race (I'm still waiting for the definitive account of that pennant race; unless it's already been written and I missed it.) What's

Amazin' about those Mets is (1) the very late surge, after 119 games, and (2) the fact that their best record of the season was just +4, way back in May, after game 34! On top of that, they beat the powerhouse Reds for the NL pennant in a memorable NLCS, and almost took the World Series from the defending champs, the Oakland A's, falling in 7 games.

The '84 Royals (84-78) made their charge after 91 games and, like the Mets (82-79), squeaked by in a relatively weak division. Unlike the Mets, they were defeated in the LCS by the Tigers, who went on to beat the Padres in the World Series.

Other tidbits: The 2001 A's and the 1951 Giants got their turnarounds, +52 and +49 games, respectively, started early: the A's romped to the AL West title, but failed in the ALCS against the Yankees, while the Giants contributed another National League "Miracle" in the 3-game playoff with the Dodgers to claim the pennant...speaking of the Dodgers, they've made the playoffs twice since 2013 after getting off to slow starts: -12 in 2013 and -10 last year.

For some perspective, 1093 teams in the group considered have been at 10 or more games under .500, with just the 12 making the post-season, for a rate of 1.1%.

#### **Question 2: Getting Your Head Above Water**

Since making the playoffs after being 15-games under .500 is so difficult, how about a relaxing the rules a bit: How many teams have ever been 15 games below .500 and finished at or above .500? Without the Post-Season criteria in play, we added back in 1904, the Federal League (1914 and 1915), 1981, and 1994. Additionally, we extended the seasons back to 1901. Here's the list, ordered by the low-water mark – the number of games below .500:

Of the 881 teams dipping 15 games below .500, only 13 finished above .500, about 1.5%.

A handful of late-season turnarounds highlight this list:

The 1991 Brewers finished with a 40-19 run. This was a bit of a good sign for the next season, as the Brewers finished 92-70, 4 games behind the division winning Blue Jays. However, keeping to form, they had to go on a late-season surge – a blistering 20-7 September – to hit 92 wins.

It took the 1992 Astros 112 games to get it going: they finished up 33-17 to finish just one game out of 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the NL West. The Bagwell-Biggio Astros were 84-78 in 1993 before landing just .5 game back of the Reds in the new NL Central in 1994 before the strike hit, wiping out the rest of the season.

The Indians' rally in 2008 was not a sign of better things, as they suffered through a series of 65-ish win seasons until breaking through in 2013.

The '62 Phillies went 30-14 down the stretch to get above .500, which put them in 7<sup>th</sup> place. The next year, they were 7 under (35-42) before going 52-33 to close out a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish. Unfortunately, in 1964, they reversed the "surge" trend, and a 2-10 collapse at the end of the year prevented them from capturing the NL pennant. They were at 90-60, then lost 6 straight – but were still hanging onto first place by .5 game. Four more losses – the last 3 to the Cardinals – ran their losing streak to 10, leaving them 2.5 games behind St. Louis. When the dust had settled, the Cardinals – who won 9 straight while the Phils were dropping 10 straight – captured the NL pennant by a game over the Phillies and the Reds, who also reeled off 9 straight while the Phillies-Cardinals drama was playing itself out. The 1969 Astros and the 1973 Cardinals had some wild swings: both *under* by 15, then hitting 10 games *over* before sliding back to .500.

We already mentioned the 2005 Astros, who made it to the World Series, but the Oakland A's also came back from 15 under in 2005. They made a great run, reaching +19 on August 30<sup>th</sup> after a 58-24 streak; they were actually 2 games in first on that day, but faded afterwards, and settled for 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the AL West.

#### **Question 3: Sinking Fast**

We've been looking at great turnarounds, but what about epic collapses? I reversed question (2) and asked: Has a team ever been 15 games over .500 and finished below .500?

I thought this would be more difficult to do. Sometimes, it takes a team a month or two to get it going, but only a good team can even get to 15 over, right? You'd think that'd be evidence of enough talent to at least hang in there and come out 5-10 games over, even if they hit a rough patch. It turns out that the Epic Collapse is just as common as the Dramatic Turnaround. Of the 940 teams that have been at least 15 games over .500, this is the group of 14 teams that managed to still finish below .500; that's about 1.5%, the same percentage as the Turnarounds.

Here's the list, ordered by the *high*-water mark – the number of games above .500:

The Indians collapse in 1905 was a result of the loss of Napoleon Lajoie, who played only 65 games, the year he also assumed managerial duties. In a bizarre injury, Lajoie let a wound from a spiking go untreated, and dye from his sock entered into his bloodstream, causing blood poisoning, resulting in sepsis. That sounds bad – and it was – but at least he avoided the amputation of his leg.

Other tidbits: In 12 of the 14 cases, the team's final record was not the bottom of the crash: for example, the 1912 Reds were 22-6 (+16), hit rock bottom at 53-63 (-10), but rebounded a bit and finished just 3 under...Last year's Phillies made the list, with a 19 game reversal in their Best-to-Worst record; this was also the latest in the season to occur (after 113 games)...the 1940 Giants and the 1985 Cubs experienced the biggest swings, -27...the '73 Cubs were looking good around All-Star Game time, but a 23-48 stretch of bad road doomed them...the Indians have the dubious distinction of appearing on this list no less than 5 times! Starting in 1941, it's about an every-20-year-occurrence, so watch out around 2030.

### Question 4: Jekyll and Hyde

The last question is sort of a search for the Jekyll-and-Hyde teams: (4) Which teams were both 15 games over *and* under during the same season?

We've already seen three of these teams: the 1914 Braves, the 2005 Astros and the 2005 A's. The final team is the 1965 Pirates, who found themselves in a big hole, with a 3-16 stretch in late April/early May doing the digging. Despite an 81-48 finish, the Bucs wound up in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 7 games behind the NL Champion Dodgers. The Pirates were a good team again in 1966 (92-70), finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> again, and became perennial NL East contenders in 1970.

These are all "turnaround" situations. No teams have been +15 or more and then wound up -15 or more. In all, there have been 2,512 "Team Seasons" since 1901, and only 4 (.16%) have ridden such a wild rollercoaster.

What lesson can we learn from our little excursion? Well, for gosh sakes, if you can at all help it, don't get to 15 games under .500. It has been nearly impossible to make the post-season if you do – only two teams out of 850 (.2%) have done so since 1903. The Wild Card helped the Astros in 2005, but don't count on the 2<sup>nd</sup> wild card bailing you out. On top of that, only about 1.5% of 881 teams since 1901 have even made it to a .500 or better record after falling to 15 or more games under. Like the plague, avoid this situation at all costs.

For fans of teams who find themselves in this very difficult situation, you can always hang your hat on the 1914 "Miracle" Braves or the 2005 Astros, but probably make it a hat you're not too fond of, just in case you lose it.

## Notes on 19th century play

From 1876-1881 and 1892-1900, the National League was the only game in town, so to speak. In between, from 1882-1891, there were several other leagues in addition to the NL: the American Association was the constant, with the Players' League (1890) and the Union Association (1884) joining for one year each. I did run the data for this period, and there were some teams that made the lists for Epic Collapses and Rollercoaster Rides, but no "Big Turnarounds."

#### **Epic Collapses and Rollercoaster Rides**

These 4 teams represent about 3% of the 134 teams getting to 15+ games over .500 during this period.

The Philadelphia Athletics of the American Association are a special case: they ran out of money late in the 1890 season and, as a last resort, responded to the crisis by releasing all of their regular players. The replacements were summarily trounced on a daily basis, and the Athletics lost their final 22 games of the season; they had been in first place as late as July 18<sup>th</sup>.

I lowered the thresholds to swings from +10 or more and -10 or more, and it nabbed a few additional teams, with two Turnarounds. The conditions were probably more conducive to these outcomes, so maybe "endemic" is too strong a word:

In the +10 and -10 range, the Turnarounds are about 1.5% (2 of 138) and the Collapses at 4.2% (7 of 167); 3 of the these 7 Collapses are also "Rollercoaster" Teams, about 1% of Team Seasons (302) of this period. Remember, too, that it's a bit harder to have these wild swings when teams are playing less than 100 games; there's not enough time, as there is in today's 162-game schedule, to make up for lost ground, or squander an advantage. It wasn't until 1884 that 100 or more games were actually scheduled.

Of the 432 teams that have made the Post-Season since 1903 (excluding the 8 from 1981), what's the spread of "Worst Records"/"Most Games Under 500"? For example, 5 teams hit a low of 9 games under .500 and still made the Post-Season:
